

My Okobojo Camp Packing List

Wow—you're packing up for your time at camp! **Have fun!** We can't wait to see you soon at Okobojo! Here's a list of some important things you will want to bring with you (and a few things to make sure you leave at home):

For every camping event please bring:

- Signed and completed "Health History & Authorization" form (mandatory)
- Signed and completed "Release of Liability Waiver" (mandatory)
- Medications needed during camp

Day Camps:

- Sunscreen & insect repellent
- Bible, pencil & paper
- Swimsuit, beach towel, sandals/water shoes, baseball hat
- Backpack or daypack
- Jackets & Sweatshirts
- Camera (don't forget charging cables, extra batteries and memory cards)
- Tennis Shoes (or other closed-toe shoes)

Overnight Camps:

- Sleeping bag (or bedding) & pillow
- Towel, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste
- Sunscreen & insect repellent
- Bible, pencil & paper
- Flashlight & extra batteries
- Swimsuit, beach towel, sandals/water shoes, baseball hat
- Clothing for each day (rainy days too!)
- Backpack or daypack
- Jackets & Sweatshirts
- Camera (don't forget charging cables, extra batteries and memory cards)
- Tennis Shoes (or other closed-toe shoes)
- Stationary & Stamps to write home

What NOT to bring:

- Money - your camp fee covers ALL expenses (food, snacks, park entrance fees, etc.). The camp store is open on check-in/closing days. Please leave money for camp souvenirs with families or a staff member.
- Cell Phones - cell phone brought to camp will be left with a staff member at camper check-in
- iPods/iTouches/MP3 players
- Sports Equipment/Fireworks/Lighters
- Extra Food/Snacks/Pop
- Video Games/Portable Computers
- Alcohol/Tobacco/Drugs/Weapons/Vehicles
